OVERVIEW

The Approved Plant List, pages E-9 to E-13, includes over 200 plants that are native and non-native to Hawaii. Although these plants are either readily available commercially or are known to be economically feasible to commercially cultivate, nursery growers should be consulted on plant size and quantity availability, prior to the specification of such plants. Whenever possible, native plants shall be given priority over non-native plants. Care must be taken to select the appropriate native plant for the right condition and location. Some native plants are more suited for use as specimens or accent rather than in mass plantings. The Approved Plant List is not exclusive; it is always being reviewed and revised.

Threatened and Endangered (T&E) Plants:

(a) T&E plants may be used in landscape if:

(1) plants were nursery-grown.

(2) the nursery was permitted by the State of Hawaii (DLNR) to grow and sell T&E plants.

(b) T&E plants used in landscape must be submitted to MCB Hawaii Environmental Departments Natural Resources section for review and receive Command Deck approval to plant.

The landscape architect should be informed that the T&E plant species may spread beyond its original planting into areas where they were not intended to grow, i.e., training areas. If T&E landscape plants are discovered in unintended areas, the US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) must be consulted to determine the disposition of the plant species.

UNDERSTANDING THE APPROVED AND PROHIBITED PLANT LISTS:

1. The APPROVED Plant List:

- It is not a static document. Always request the most current approved/prohibited list.
- If a tree is not on the APPROVED plant list, and the designer/landscape architect would like to use the plant, it SHALL be evaluated by the MCB Hawaii's Natural Resources Staff, Base Arborist, or NAVFAC Hawaii Landscape Architect as to whether it will be permitted to be planted on Base.
- When selecting a plant on the one of the Approved Plant lists, regardless whether it is native,
 Polynesian introduction, or a non-invasive, non-native, the designer/landscape architect should
 understand the environment where the plant chosen will be installed. For example, vine like/crawling
 type ground cover should not be used near sidewalks, driveways, and streets; do not call-out a mesicadapted tree/shrub for a dry coastal planting, etc.

2. The PROHIBITED Plant List:

- If a plant is not on the PROHIBITED Plant List, it does NOT infer it is an approved plant.
- Any plant on the PROHIBITED Plant List shall NOT be installed on MCB Hawaii properties.
- This List is not inclusive nor is it a static list.
- All Plants on this list fall into one of more categories highly invasive, poisonous, or thorny.

It is strongly recommended using the assistance of a licensed landscape architect in the State of Hawaii in selecting plants appropriate to the each MCB Hawaii installation to ensure the size and installation of plant material is given so the plants selected will have an increased chance of survival. The landscape architect must use personal knowledge and experience in selecting the appropriate materials for each site specific situation.

Native Plants:

Native Hawaiian plants are defined as those that arrived to a location on their own via natural processes, typically by 'wind, water or wing'.

Hawaiian native plants are categorized as either "indigenous" or "endemic". Plants in general are considered native if they found their way to Hawaii by wind, water or wings; this applies to both endemic and indigenous plants. A native "endemic" plant evolved into a unique and significantly different species, and now is found only in Hawaii and nowhere else in the world; it begins and ENDS in Hawaii. Native plants have adapted to survive in harsh and often inhospitable conditions. They often require less water, care and maintenance. They are also an important part of a region's biological and cultural heritage. This is particularly true in Hawaii where native plants were used for food, cordage, medicine, clothing, and construction. The use of native plants in ornamental landscapes encourages cultivation, which helps prevent extinction of species.

Hawaii has approximately 1,100 known native plant species. Of these plants, 90% are considered endemic. This is due to the age of the island chain and our isolation in the middle of the Pacific Ocean. These two factors, coupled with the fact that Hawaii was once completely void of many of the plant predators common to the rest of the world has resulted in the diversity that has made native Hawaiian plants very unique.

A Presidential Memorandum, released on April 26, 1994 (Refer to the "Appendix", Section H, Page H-15), directs federal agencies, "where cost effective and to the extent practicable, to use regionally native plants for landscaping", along with employing landscape practices that conserve water and prevent pollution. Similarly, a State of Hawaii law (HRS 103D-408) requires the State to incorporate indigenous and Polynesian-introduced plants into its landscaping projects whenever and wherever feasible.

Like introduced plants, native plants that are appropriate for landscaping in one location may not be appropriate in another. Plant native plants in conditions similar to where they would naturally be found. Native plants should be acquired from nurseries from growers and landscape contractors that are familiar with the laws and ethics associated with the cultivation of native plants.

Polynesian Introductions:

Approximately 33 species of plants were brought to Hawaii by the Polynesian voyagers in their canoes. These plants are not native but introduced species, although many have been here for over 1,000 years. However, plants that are appropriate in one location may not be appropriate in another. It is best to plant Polynesian-introduced species in conditions similar to where they would naturally be found.

Invasive Species:

Alien plants are a serious threat to Hawaii's unique native flora and ecosystems. These plants smother native vegetation, displace native species or prevent their reestablishment.

The State of Hawaii Department of Land & Natural Resources (DLNR), Division of Forestry & Wildlife's (DOFAW) list of "Hawaii's Most Invasive Horticultural Plants" and the Oahu Invasive Species Committee (OISC), the Hawaii-Pacific Weed Risk Assessment, and the most current version of the Landscape Industry Council of Hawaii's Invasive Plant List should be consulted, when selecting plant material for a project.

Executive Order 13112, Invasive Species (3 February 1999) seeks to prevent the introduction of invasive species and provides for their control to minimize the economic, ecological and human health impacts caused by invasive species. Federal agencies are required, to the extent practicable and permitted by law, to prevent the introduction of invasive species, to control their populations, to restore native species and habitat in ecosystems that have been invaded, and to promote public education on invasive species.
