**DRAFT FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (FONSI)
FOR
REDEVELOPMENT OF MARFORPAC HQ/OPS CENTER,
CAMP H.M. SMITH, OAHU, HAWAII**

SUMMARY: Pursuant to the Council on Environmental Quality Regulations implementing the National Environmental Policy Act, Marine Corps Base Hawaii, provides notice that a Draft FONSI has been prepared, based on an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the redevelopment of the existing Marine Forces, Pacific (MARFORPAC) headquarters and operations (HQ/OPS) center at Camp Smith, Oahu, Hawaii.

The Draft FONSI considers findings from the formal Section 106 consultation conducted pursuant to Title 36 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 800, Protection of Historic Properties, Section 106 Regulations, regarding potential impacts to cultural resources from the planned redevelopment of MARFORPAC's existing HQ/OPS Center known as the Building 1 Complex.
