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Aloha e June, Section 106 committee, and all participants,

Mahalo to everyone involved and especially to all across Hawaii nei who supported the "no military training actions on Molokai" island. Mahalo for your insight and compassion to the patients of Kalaupapa and the Hawaiian homesteaders of Hoolehua, Molokai. For the record, I continue to petition all signatories NOT TO SIGN this current and "final" PA until all of the proposed undertakings on Molokai island are OMITTED FROM THIS PA. Furthermore, as I stated on the record of the July 5, 2012 final consultation meeting, the determination by MCBH and the Navy of "no effect" to the APE proposed "Arming and Refueling Point" in Homestead lands in Hoolehua, Molokai is in error. I stated that there were cultural sites and I will be forwarding that information to you when I get back to Molokai this week. Also, no mitigation exists in the final PA for Kalupapa APE which you determined to be impacted. Continuing a "baseline of training events" impacting significant sites and the patients in Kalaupapa does not constitute mitigation for adverse impacts to a significant cultural/spiritual National Historical Landmark! AUWE! Bottom line it is clear MCBH/Navy wants a footprint on Molokai no matter the cost. There was never any real alternatives to Molokai which constitutes "stacking". MCBH has the option to move forward with their entire proposed undertakings without Molokai in the mix and the only way they will come to that conclusion is if SHPO and all other signatory decline to sign the PA.

For the record, as the person being affected by your undertaking, I cannot agree to sign your PA as written. For the record, because I cannot agree to sign this final PA does not excuse the Federal government from consulting with myself and other declining signatory for further discussion of your proposed undertakings on our islands.

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Aloha e Kanaka and all section 106 participants,

Aloha from Molokai. Mahalo again to all those who have made it their kuleana to protect our aina and to the signatories who stand in solidarity with us by choosing NOT TO SIGN the Programmatic Agreement (PA) for the basing of the Navy's MV22 and H-1 Aircraft elements in Hawaii at Marine Corp Base Hawaii (MCBH) and the associated training throughout the state. Yes, we are disappointed that the State Historic Preservation Officer William Aila (SHPO) chose to sign the PA despite strong statewide opposition over several months. It was stated for the record several times not only through the statewide 106 consultations but also through the DLNR Listening sessions and SHPO Listening session on Molokai that the entire island of Molokai is a cultural site and should be treated as such. MCBH, the Navy, SHPO and all other who continue to move forward in support of this PA has left us here on Molokai with no recourse but to erect a visible and tangible representation of our cultural significance to these lands by way of the placement of an ahu on the proposed MCBH/Navy "Forward Arming and Refueling" site in Hoolehua, Molokai in protest. Please see the attached picture. The building of this ahu was done following correct cultural protocol and a KAPU has been placed on it. The mana of our people here on Molokai has been given to this ahu. Any attempt to remove this cultural site will be seen as desecration. MCBH and Navy, do not desecrate this cultural site. The threat of "excommunicating" those who do not sign this PA citing federal law is absurd. We state for the record our willingness to continue with earnest discussion on MCBH and the Navy's proposed actions on Molokai and throughout the state of Hawaii and hope that they will do so.

Historic Hawai'i Foundation has received the Marine Corps' invitation to concur in the Programmatic Agreement referenced above. After much reflection and discussion, we respectfully decline the request.

Historic Hawai'i Foundation (HHF) is a statewide not-for-profit corporation incorporated in 1974 for the purpose of preserving and encouraging the preservation of sites, buildings, districts, objects and communities significant to the history of Hawai'i. HHF has been a consulting party to the USMC on the proposed undertaking under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

HHF appreciates the meetings, site visits, teleconferences and information provided to the consulting parties by Marine Corps Base Hawaii (MCBH) Cultural Resources personnel regarding the Hawaii Basing of the MV-22 and H-1 Aircraft at MCBH. HHF has been involved in the consultation since November 2010, including participation in frequent and intense discussions about the scope of the undertaking, identification of historic properties that will be affected by it, and efforts to avoid, minimize and mitigation those effects.

We would like to express our appreciation for the stipulations in the Programmatic Agreement related to additional planning and design development related to the Bachelor Enlisted Quarters and the MAG Headquarters Building. This issue was of particular concern for us, and we commit to participate in the discussion and review of future plans for these areas as a "Design Review Partner." We expect our participation to be meaningful and productive, and we thank you for the opportunity.

However, despite the design review process, the undertaking is still anticipated to include significant levels of demolition of historic properties, with a minimum of five and potentially more historic buildings to be destroyed. Throughout the consultation process, HHF recommended and requested





that mitigation specifically for this loss be addressed. In particular, we felt that the areas of Marine Corps Base Hawai'i that have been identified as eligible for the National Register of Historic Places should be nominated to the National Register; that Preservation Plans be developed for both the Administrative and Aviation historic districts; and that future undertakings be consistent with those Preservation Plans.

While we appreciate the stipulations related to education and outreach materials to be developed and installed at MCBH, we remain concerned that these stipulations will be difficult to enforce in a timely manner, as they are reliant on separate and unrelated funding sources, rather than being tied directly to a specific project that would cause the adverse effect. HHF feels that the PA's mitigation measures are not adequate or proportionate for an undertaking of this magnitude.

In addition, HHF is deeply concerned with the anticipated use of Kalaupapa National Historic Park for any aspect of the undertaking. Kalaupapa is a National Historic Landmark, and an area of deep cultural, historic and spiritual significance to the residents of the peninsula, the communities of Moloka'i and the people of Hawai'i. The proposed use of Kalaupapa for training for war and conflict is incompatible with the character and values of this historic site. Despite extensive discussion about USMC's proposal and numerous objections to it, USMC has been intransigent in its insistence on using the property for training and operations.

For these reasons, HHF will not concur with the Programmatic Agreement. We do extend our thanks for the professionalism displayed by the MCBH and NAVFACPAC cultural resources staff throughout the consultation process. We look forward to working with them on reviewing the aspects of the consultation that worked well, and aspects that could be improved, for the development of the "Best Practices" report.

Ka 'Ohana O Kalaupapa has appreciated the opportunity to participate in the Section 106 consultations regarding the proposed undertakings of the Marine Corps regarding increased training exercises by military helicopters or construction/renovation of facilities associated with those exercises.

The 'Ohana wants to thank the military for eliminating any increased landings of these helicopters at Kalaupapa which we consider to be a sacred place where the quiet is essential for the reverent atmosphere. We are grateful that the Marine Corps realized that the original proposal of increasing the number of annual landings at Kalaupapa by nearly 2,200 was inappropriate and disrespectful of the thousands of people buried here, of the current residents and of family members who come to visit the graves of their kupuna. Kalaupapa will soon be the home to two Saints – which may be unprecedented for such a small community anywhere in the world – and will also become the location of a Memorial honoring all of those who were sent to Kalaupapa because of government policies regarding leprosy. The Marines should be congratulated for listening to us and changing their position, opting to look for alternate sites such as Dillingham to conduct these exercises.

However, the 'Ohana Board of Directors still does not feel comfortable signing this Programmatic Agreement. While we are pleased that Kalaupapa is no longer included in the new undertakings, we realize that other communities did not get the same results that we did. We are particularly concerned that it appears that there will be additional clearing and paving at the Molokai Forward Arming and Refueling Point at Ho'olehua to accommodate MV-22 and H-1 squadrons – and that concerns on topside Molokai have not been adequately addressed. The MV-22 Osprey helicopters that apparently will be part of these operations raises additional concerns.



During a public meeting held on March 27, 2012, in Kaunakakai that was attended by nearly 50 people, no one spoke in favor of the increased exercises at Kalaupapa or Ho`olehua. Many testified against any helicopter landings anywhere on Molokai. Even veterans testified against the training exercises because the loud noise of the helicopters can trigger post-traumatic stress syndrome in those who have served this nation in wars.


The 'Ohana Board feels we must stand with the topside Molokai community just as they stood with us to oppose any increased landings at Kalaupapa.

This is not meant to be an anti-military or a "military go back to the Mainland" stance. Members of the Board of Ka 'Ohana O Kalaupapa who live at Kalaupapa do not oppose the current level of training exercises being conducted there - 112 annual landings that take place between 7 and 11 p.m. There are those around Hawaii who have opposed any training exercises at Kalaupapa, but our 'Ohana leaders who live here do not. It should also be noted that there are veterans buried in Kalaupapa, men who served in war who were later sent to Kalaupapa after being diagnosed with leprosy. We honor all of our veterans.

We ask that the Marine Corps continue to work with all communities who oppose these training exercises and try to develop ways that training can occur in areas where they cause the least amount of disturbance.

We hope the Marine Corps understands our position. We look forward to working with you in the future.

There are many issues involved with this plan that have not been addressed in a manner that has truly incorporated a voice of not only our people the Kanaka Maoli, our people specifically called upon to address cultural, historical concerns under Section 106, but also whole communities of people across ka pae'aina 'o Hawai'i nei who are not native but who truly want to protect our historic, cultural sites and the environment. This plan, MCB Hawaii MV-22/H-1 Aircraft, is being bullied on us all.

Regarding Mo'okapu, there are ceded lands at Mo'okapu, national lands. It is not right to say you will not discuss this as a part of the EIS.

Any plans for new construction that involves digging into areas that have been described as sand dunes of Mo'okapu and thus burial grounds, our Ohana absolutely opposes and warns you to cease and desist any disturbance of our kupuna.

There should be a separate, independent study of the Ethnohistory of Mo'okapu. We do not support the Marines conducting their own study. We hope the Office of Hawaiian Affairs and other Hawaiian civic groups getting involved to conduct and fund an ethnohistory of Mo'okapu that truly speaks to the history, beauty and legacy of this very important wahi pana.

The Marines should stop any further construction at Mo'okapu and should instead work on a plan to decrease their construction and decommission parts of Mo'okapu that can be returned to our people immediately. Work with our people to truly reconcile past harms in a pono way.

Anyone who works in buildings or lives in homes, or drives on the roads, or plays golf on the sand dunes of Mo'okapu should be fully apprised of the existence of human remains on that property and why it exists. Any military personnel who sign a lease agreement to live in a house on Mo'okapu should be fully informed in a legal real estate transaction, about the presence of human remains and why it is there.

Further, my position to NOT sign this PA agreement should not exclude me from consultation. There is harm, adverse impacts, injury on our wahi pana. All Kanaka Maoli, Native Hawaiian organizations must be included in any further consultation and kept fully informed about what the Marines, the Navy or the Department of Defense intend to continue to do or plan on our wahi pana despite our objections.

Hawaii's Thousand Friends (HTF) appreciates the opportunity to participate in the National Historic Preservation Act Section 106 process as a consulting party but must decline the request to concur with the Programmatic Agreement.

Particularly troubling was the proposed increased military use of Kalaupapa Airport for training flights. Kalaupapa is a national landmark of spiritual and cultural significance to its residents and the people of Hawai`i nei so we are pleased that the additional training flights at Kalaupapa Airport have been eliminated.

Section 106 requires federal agencies to determine how historic properties might be affected and explore measures to avoid or reduce harm to historic properties.

Yet the PA that we are asked to sign states that the *Marine Corps has determined that the effects on historic properties cannot be fully determined **before** approval of the Undertaking* and that some areas *have not been adequately inventoried and may require additional identification effort.* (Emphasis added)

Under these circumstances it is impossible for Hawaii's Thousand Friends to sign this PA.

On behalf of the Ko`olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club, the Ko`olau Foundation, and Kako`o`Oiwai, we regret to inform the U.S. Navy that we will be unable to sign the programmatic agreement for various reasons already stated in earlier communications but also for this reason:

It is our belief that the plan to expand military operations at various locations in Hawai`i was pre-determined and decided, long before we began these consultations. While we appreciate everyone's efforts to improve on the plan, we continue to object to the fact that the U.S. government proceeds with its undertakings before 106 consultations or EIS mitigations are adequately completed or addressed.

It is inappropriate that serious implementation of the proposed expansion and training actually began before our consultations were completed. As was said before, it makes a mockery of the many hours of time and effort donated by our community advocates and native Hawaiians who came to the table to offer their suggestions for improving the plan.

Albeit at this late date, we wish, for the record, to repeat some of the earlier concerns we raised:

- 1) That the proposed flight patterns take your aircraft over land areas where residents and farms are located, and we are concerned about chemical drift that may affect our food crops and streams that are important to native Hawaiian cultural practices.
- 2) That the proposed flight patterns take your aircraft over Kane`ohe bay, disturbing cultural practitioners who are engaged in fishing or other practices in and around the bay.
- 3) That the times during which your training would take place may disturb Hawaiian cultural activities that require discussions or pule (prayers) that would be interrupted by the loud sounds of aircraft overhead.

The Boyd ohana has had a long standing objection to development and action taken on Mokapuby the DOD. in the absence of the commitment by the Navy to resolve title issues and MCBH to commit to reburial are on record although consistently ignored because of the limitations of the 106 process and NAGPRA. Limitations in notice to those who have been identified as lineal descendants under past practices and old law only has been problematic for the protection of the collective in perpetuity. This PA reflects an over reaching activity by the DOD and has implications that affect the lahui on all islands by virtue of genealogy. The burden to provide notice on all islands falls on the DOD simply because it is going to engage in the offensive activity. So to minimize the compliance as a matter of convenience is also on the DOD and not the Native Hawaiian for failure to object or point it out. Unilateral decision making based on flawed process results in a flawed decision and this is on the DOD as well. These issues have been raised and ignored by MCBH as a matter of convenience and funding. Consultation is not meaningful and proper without proper notice and meetings, which have been consistent concerns raised by Native Hawaiians for many years. Long standing concerns left unaddressed result in an overwhelming response from those Native Hawaiians invited to participate in this PA and who have no other option based on legal historical and cultural context but to refuse to sign the PA.

Does the DOD have the unilateral ability to take the proposed action? If it does, it is on the DOD. Native Hawaiians and their organized NHO have overwhelmingly objected to the proposed action by refusing to sign. The Boyd Ohana joins in the collective objection.

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) is in receipt of the final Programmatic Agreement (PA) to support the proposed Basing of MV-22 and H-1 Aircraft aboard Marine Corps Base Hawai'i in Support of III Marine Expeditionary Force Elements in Hawai'i (the undertaking). This PA was transmitted to OHA and other consulting parties via email dated July 12, 2012 from the Marine Corps Base Hawai'i (MCBH)-Cultural Resources Manager.

It is our understanding that a hardcopy of this PA was sent (with attachments on a CD) via U.S. Mail to the three parties listed as "signatories": 1. Brian Annichiarico, Colonel, U.S. Marine Corps (USMC) Commanding Officer; 2. William Aila, Hawai'i State Historic Preservation Officer; and 3. John M. Fowler, Executive Director, Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). By email dated July 16, 2012 consulting parties were notified by the State of Hawai'i- Department of Land and Natural Resources, State Historic Preservation Division Administrator that the Hawai'i State Historic Preservation Officer had signed the PA. Whether the USMC and ACHP have also signed the PA is unknown to OHA at this time.<sup>1</sup>

A hardcopy of the PA was also sent to all other parties listed as “invited signatories” and “concurring parties”<sup>2</sup> to provide an opportunity for these parties to formally sign the PA. In general, OHA does not view our signing of a National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) agreement document as offering our outright or unconditional support for a given undertaking. Likewise, when OHA declines to sign an NHPA agreement document, this should not be construed to be our outright opposition to a given undertaking. Our support for, or opposition to a given undertaking will be explicitly stated in our formal correspondence letters.

At this juncture, OHA recognizes that multiple concurring parties, including certain Native Hawaiian Organizations (NHO) have formally declined the opportunity to sign this PA because of a broad range of unresolved concerns that have been consistently expressed for the duration of these concurring parties’ participation in the NHPA consultation process to develop this PA.

As we acknowledged in our April 5, 2012 letter to you, the USMC initiated early NHPA consultation for this undertaking with OHA in November of 2010. The first draft of the PA was transmitted to consulting parties via email on January 26, 2012 and the first formal consultation meeting to discuss this first draft of the PA was held on February 2, 2012. As we stated in our April 5, 2012 letter to you, OHA views this period of time (January 26-February 2, 2012) as the point when meaningful NHPA specific to the development of a PA began.

NHPA consultation to develop the PA concluded on July 6, 2012. Thus, consulting parties who participated in the entire five (5) months of NHPA consultation to develop the PA were engaged in an effort to comprehensively assess an undertaking that proposed activities within a geographic area extending from Ka’ula Island to Hawai’i Island. OHA believes that it is reasonable to assert that the demands placed on consulting parties in terms of the time, resources and expertise required to participate in NHPA consultation for this undertaking are unprecedented in the State of Hawai’i.

OHA offers our sincere appreciation to all USMC, MCBH- Environmental Compliance and Protection Department and Department of the Navy-Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Pacific personnel and staff for the level of professionalism and dedication you have displayed for the duration of the NHPA consultation process for this undertaking. OHA recognizes that each one of you have been charged with the tremendous responsibility of taking into account the adverse effects of this undertaking on historic properties while also being mindful of larger Department of Defense mission requirements and legally mandated responsibilities.

With this being said, OHA fully realizes that the above mentioned appreciation and recognition does little and perhaps absolutely nothing for our beneficiaries who are adamantly opposed to this overall undertaking, specific activities associated with the undertaking, or the conclusion of the NHPA consultation process to develop this PA. OHA respectfully reminds the USMC that NHPA implementing regulations require you to provide *summaries of the views, along with copies of any written comments, provided by affected Indian tribes and Native Hawaiian Organizations to the Council as part of the documentation for the proposed program alternative*<sup>3</sup> and that the USMC and ACHP are required to *take those views into account in reaching a final decision on the proposed program alternative.*<sup>4</sup>

While OHA acknowledges that the USMC has taken into account certain comments provided in our April 5, 2012 and July 6, 2012 letters to you and that this has resulted in revised language being incorporated into the final PA, OHA believes certain fundamental issues and concerns that we have previously expressed relative to this undertaking remain unresolved at this time. As I have previously mentioned in this letter, other consulting parties, including certain NHO have formally declined the opportunity to sign this PA and have provided the specific reasons for their decision in writing.

OHA will not commit to signing the PA as a concurring party at this time. In order to fulfill our mandates to the Hawaiian people however, OHA will be participating in all stipulations of the PA relative to the Hawaiian people under the authority of Stipulation I(C)(3) of the PA which states that *...parties that elect not to sign the PA as Concurring Parties will still have an opportunity to participate in certain aspects of the PA, such as Design Review or ongoing NHO consultations.*

OHA notes that until this PA executed through signatures from the USMC and ACHP, the administrative process to resolve the concerns expressed by consulting parties remains open. It is certainly appropriate that the USMC and ACHP recognize the opportunity you have to continue NHPA consultation to address any unresolved concerns administratively. Once the administrative process is closed, each consulting party will individually and/or collectively consider any other processes that are available to resolve our concerns. Should the USMC and ACHP move forward and execute the PA, all consulting parties shall be so notified by the USMC as required by NHPA implementing regulations.<sup>5</sup>

As a closing comment, OHA applauds the representatives of all consulting parties who have participated in the discussions relative to this undertaking, but especially those NHO representatives who have spent a considerable amount of time taken away from other responsibilities to honor and reaffirm the teachings of our ancestors and fulfill the inherent kuleana we have to protect the resources of our only homeland for current and future generations.

These additional written comments explicitly decline the opportunity to sign this PA and specifically reference a broad range of unresolved concerns that have been consistently expressed for the duration of these parties' participation in the NHPA consultation process to develop this PA.

As I am sure you know, the NHPA implementing regulations promulgated by the ACHP require that the USMC provide your organization with *summaries of the views, along with copies of any written comments, provided by affected Indian tribes and Native Hawaiian Organizations to the Council as part of the documentation for the proposed program alternative*<sup>2</sup> and that the USMC and ACHP are both required to *take those views into account in reaching a final decision on the proposed program alternative*.<sup>3</sup> OHA is confident that after you have had the opportunity to review and consider all of the written comments relative to this PA that have been transmitted by certain NHO and consulting parties, you will recognize the need to seriously consider leaving the administrative process open at this time by declining to sign this PA.

I will also ask you to consider whether the consultation process that has been employed for this undertaking adheres to the guidance provided in the ACHP's landmark publication *Consultation with Native Hawaiian Organizations in the Section 106 Review Process: A Handbook*. While OHA recognizes that the guidance in your handbook may not be a requirement for other Federal agencies, it is reasonable to expect that the ACHP would verify that your guidance on NHPA consultation has been followed by other Federal agencies before contributing to the execution of an NHPA agreement document.
