

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SCHOOL BUS TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION



Pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rule (HAR) 8-27-5, students in Grades K-5 must reside a mile or more from the school within their attendance area. Students in Grade 6-12 must reside 1.5 miles or more from the school within their attendance area in order to receive regular school bus service.

Students who do not qualify for regular bus service may receive "space available" bus service *if there are unused seats on the bus and that accommodation will not result in additional cost to the State.*

Bus Pass Rates for SY 2011-2012	
Roundtrip Annually	\$ 270.00
Quarterly Roundtrip	\$ 72.00
Coupons by sheet (10 coupons/sheet)	\$ 10.25

Policies

1. No refund policy on school bus pass; effective immediately
2. Flat rate is applied with equal weight no matter when you start or end school (again, no refunds). The value of a bus pass remains constant; it does not lose value over time; flat rate pricing is identical to city bus
3. Methods of payment: check / money order / cash / cashier's check

NOTE: schools may exclude personal checks as an acceptable payment form; schools have the authority to set specific dates and times when bus payments are accepted.
