- 1. <u>Situation</u>. Reference (a) directs all Marine Corps Bases to develop a Hazardous Waste Management Plan, which is contained in reference (b). This plan establishes regulatory requirements, personnel responsibilities, and clear-concise procedures for managing hazardous and non-hazardous regulated waste aboard Marine Corps Base Hawaii (MCBH).
- 2. Cancellation. BaseO 6280.8
- 3. <u>Mission</u>. MCBH has taken a quantitative and proactive approach to compliance with DoD and Marine Corps policy regarding hazardous waste management. This plan is a compilation of all applicable federal, state, and military requirements including best management practices in the daily operation of hazardous substances on board MCBH. Through integration of personnel responsibilities, technology, and a systematic approach to hazardous waste management we ensure MCBH leads the field as the base of choice for DoD in regards to Hazardous Waste Management.

## 4. Execution

- a. <u>Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations</u>. Reference (b) has been revised. The contents are substantially different from BaseO 6280.8 and should be reviewed thoroughly.
- 5. Administration and Logistics. The directives control point (DCP) for this manual is the Director of the Environmental Compliance & Protection Department, MCBH. The DCP will maintain a binder containing a locator sheet and record of changes for reference (b). The Director of the Environmental Compliance & Protection Department will determine distribution for reference (b). The recipients of reference (b) are responsible for
