Greetings,

Thank you for participating in and utilizing the MCBH PMO House Check Program. The purpose of this program is to help with protecting your property and the early detection of burglary, vandalism, and other crimes. Participation in the MCBH PMO House Check Program does not guarantee that your home will not fall victim to criminal activity and PMO assumes no liability. The program consists of: your application for participation in the program, a crime prevention brief focused on home crime prevention, and house checks of your home by PMO personnel while the residence is unoccupied.

The application and relating forms help us collect all necessary information needed for participation in the program. During this time the requirements to participate in the MCBH PMO House Check Program will be discussed, and information on anyone currently residing in the household and information on anyone that will be checking your residence while unoccupied will be recorded.

After the application is completed and the necessary information is collected a Crime Prevention Officer will go over home crime prevention information with you. The information will be tips and steps you can take on an everyday basis to ensure your home becomes a "hard" target for a potential criminal. The Crime Prevention Officer will also go over preventive steps you should take prior to leaving your home unoccupied.

At the start date indicated on your application PMO personnel will drive-by and conduct an exterior mobile patrol of your home. These house checks will occur three times a day once on every patrol watch and every house check will be annotated. If anything suspicious is observed by PMO personnel while conducting a house check of your home you will be contacted immediately and PMO will take the appropriate actions.

At the end date indicated on your application or upon returning and contacting the Crime Prevention Division the house checks will be cancelled for your home. You must contact the Crime Prevention Division at the end date or upon returning. A Crime Prevention Officer will meet with you and give you a copy of the annotated house checks of your home and answer any questions you may have.

Thank you again for your participation in the MCBH PMO House Check Program. If you have any questions before, during, or after your participation in the program feel free to contact the Crime Prevention Division at any time.
