Prevent Storm Water Pollution

What You Can Do: No Dumping, Drains to Ocean



MCBH's storm drain system was built to collect and transport rain to prevent flooding on base. Anything that flows or is discharged into the storm drain system goes directly into our streams and the ocean. Do your part and ensure nothing other than clean water goes down these drains!

- Avoid washing your vehicle at home. Use the car wash station located near the corner of Mokapu Blvd. and Harris Ave. as it is equipped to handle the chemicals.
- Bag your trash and store it in a receptacle with a lid. Un-bagged trash in your bin or the back of your truck may be blown away.
- Rake yard clippings when possible, and put them in your green bin.
- Pick up after your pets. Unremoved pet waste decays, gets washed to the ocean, and can sicken marine life such as endangered Hawaiian monk seals.
- Don't pour anything down the storm drain.
