Background: Marine Corps Base Hawaii (MCBH) has "One" of Three **Landfills** on the island of O'ahu.

Purpose: Procedures are established to ensure compliance with Hawaii State landfill permit regulations. Items in MCBH govt dumpsters go directly to the landfill. Recyclables, tires, and other items listed below are prohibited and a violation of the state permit.

Govt dumpsters are for Barracks and Unit worksite use. Base Housing and contractor waste are NOT accepted at the landfill/govt dumpsters. Refer to Housing and contract disposal procedures.

Bag All Trash: MCBH-BO 5233.1A Litter and Trash Order requires all garbage to be bagged and tied before placing in the govt dumpsters.

Barracks Residents: Follow these Recycle & Waste Guide procedures.

Base Housing Residents: Follow Housing procedures for proper disposal of household waste, bulky items, appliances, televisions.

Prohibited and not allowed in govt dumpsters.

Units bring their recyclables to Recycle Center b/132. Need bins or guidance? Contact 808-479-7364.

- **Paper:** White Paper and Colored Paper. No CUI (security)
- **Cardboard Corrugated**: No food/pizza boxes. Flatten & break down before putting in bin.
- HI-5 Aluminum Cans, Glass, Plastic Bottles: No Spit; No Contaminated containers. Request rinse clean.
- **Toner Cartridges:** In original vendor box.
- Metals: No Tactical or Aircraft parts
- Wood & Green Waste –Separate unusable (painted, treated, damaged) from usable wood and other waste. Unusable wood and green waste must be less than 5 feet long, no heavy metal attached.

Painted wood: Contact Base Safety 257-1830 (b/279) for lead testing.

Green waste: Not accepted from contractors or POVs.

 Material that Presents a Potential Explosive Hazard (MPPEH) and Material Documented as Safe (MDAS)

Spent brass casings .50 caliber & below: Unit Certifier/Verifier approved by MPPEH Manager turn-in spent brass to b/132 Recycle Center with Form 1348-1.

Live ammo: Turn-in to Ammunition Supply Point, 257-8400.

Prohibited and not allowed in govt dumpsters.

- Government issued tires: Take to your Unit's motor pool for disposal.
- Personal tires: <u>Return used tires</u> at location of purchase (for example, Firestone).
- Abandoned tires: Base Motor T accepts them at b/352. Contact Motor T/Landfill Manager at 257-2304 to coordinate turn-in.

<u>Hazardous Waste (HW)</u>

Prohibited and not allowed in govt dumpsters. Contact your Unit Env Compliance Coord, your Shop HW Coordinator, or the Base HW Site b/6409, 257-9913 for turn-in instructions.

HW includes, but is not limited to; batteries (lead acid, alkaline, lithium), paint, fluorescent light bulbs and solvents.

• Government Property

Prohibited and not allowed in govt dumpsters.

- Government-issued Appliances, Furniture. Contact Base Property, 257-6711 or Base Property Turn-In Point b/139, 808-479-7364 for disposal procedures.
- **Government-issued Computers**. Contact S-6 (Computer & Information) b/208 at 257-3070
- Government-issued electronics / TVs. to DRMO
- Dumpster Inspection

Base Motor T driver inspects govt dumpsters at every pickup for prohibited items & unbagged trash. A Dumpster Violation Report identifying location, assigned unit, and reasons for the violation are sent to unit's command. Dumpsters will not be emptied until the unit corrects the violation and contacts Base Motor T at 257-2304.

<u>Re-Use/Donation Sites</u>:

• Base Re-Use Room:

Base Housing residents may turn-in usable but unwanted household hazardous materials (e.g. unused paints and household cleaners). Then anyone and everyone may take it home for FREE! Items are for home use only. Established to prevent pollution of household chemicals in landfills. Re-Use Room location is MCBH Kaneohe Bay Building 6409, phone 808-257-0770/9913.

• Donation Sites Off-Base: Everyone and anyone can donate personal reusable items to off-base charities and organizations. Locations are listed on <u>www.honolulu.gov/</u> <u>opala.org</u> City & County of Honolulu website.
