MCBH ANNOUNCES AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT 2023 STORM WATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM PLAN

Marine Corps Base Hawaii (MCBH), Kaneohe Bay invites the public to review and comment on the draft 2023 Storm Water Management Program Plan (SWMP Plan).

The 30-day Public Comment Period for this plan runs from February 1 through March 1, 2023.

INTRODUCTION

Under the Clean Water Act (CWA), the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the State of Hawaii Department of Health (DOH) established environmental programs to protect U.S. waters.

Storm water in urbanized areas is regulated through the CWA's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program through municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) permits. MS4 permits are designed to control and prevent storm water from discharging pollutants into streams, lakes, wetlands, and coastal waters.

STORM WATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AT MCBH

Storm water is the rain runoff that flows over the ground surface into storm drains or directly into streams and rivers which lead to Hawaii's beaches and ocean. The key to storm water pollution prevention is to use **best management practices (BMPs)** to protect water quality and reduce the potential for pollution associated with storm water runoff.

MCBH continues to implement its **Storm Water Management Program (SWMP)** to comply with their MS4 Permit No. HI S000007 ("Permit").

The Permit addresses the discharge of storm water runoff, including certain non-storm water discharges from the MS4, and storm water associated with industrial activity.

The MCBH SWMP Plan is designed to reduce, to the maximum extent practicable, the amount of storm water containing pollutants from entering and ultimately discharging from the MCBH MS4 into the nearby receiving waters, specifically Kaneohe Bay, Nuupia, Halekou, and Kaluapuhi Ponds, Kailua Bay, and the Mokapu Central Drainage Channel.

In accordance with Part D.1 of the Permit, a SWMP Plan has been developed. The plan outlines the MCBH program to address storm water pollution associated with operations and activities at the installation.

Storm water management is a key part of an integrated approach to sustainable communities, which is consistent with Federal and State goals.
