### POTENTIAL HAZARDOUS WASTES :



#### IGNITABLE

Fuels, Flammable Compressed Gases, Oxidizers – Gasoline, Aviation Fuel, Propane Cylinders, Pool Chemicals



#### CORROSIVE

Acids, Bases – Battery Fluid, Muriatic Acid, Drain Cleaners, Bleach, Paint Removers



#### TOXIC

Medicines, Lead (containing items), Mercury (containing items), Paints



#### REACTIVE

Explosives, Aerosol Cans, Non-flammable Compressed Gas Cylinders, Water Reactives – Ammunition, Lithium Batteries, Nitrogen



# SAFE STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE



- Have Safety Data Sheets on hand for all known materials
- Identify Hazardous Waste Storage Areas with signage
- Mark and label all HW containers with the words “Hazardous Waste” “Item Name” and what makes it hazardous, Ignitable, Toxic, Corrosive
- Protect containers from the environment – rain, wind, direct sunlight
- HW Storage container must be compatible with the waste inside the container – Refer to Safety Data Sheet
- Keep incompatibles separated by wall, berm, or other physical means – Refer to Safety Data Sheets for incompatibilities
- Keep all containers closed and in good condition: no rust, dings, bulges
- Keep all liquid HW on secondary containment
- Do not store more than 55 gallons of HW over 72 hours
- Have spill response material to respond to spills for the types of waste stored. **In the event of a spill contact: 808.630.8246**
- Have fire extinguisher in the appropriate size and type for material stored – Refer to Safety Data Sheet, Base Safety, Fed Fire Department
