Marine Corps Base Hawaii Summarized Report of Results of Trial

April 30 - 11 May 2018

- At a General Court-Martial, in Kaneohe Bay, Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a Military Judge convicted Sergeant Dominique L. Noel, USMC, of Conspiracy to Commit Larceny, Dereliction in the Performance of Duties, Larceny, and Forgery. The accused was adjudged a Bad Conduct Discharge, 2 years confinement, total forfeitures, and reduction to E-1.
- At a General Court-Martial, in Kaneohe Bay, Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a Court Martial Panel convicted Sergeant Thomas E. Mader III, USMC, of failures to obey a lawful general order or regulation and assaults consummated by battery. The accused was adjudged a Bad Conduct Discharge, 190 days confinement, total forfeitures, and reduction to E-1.
