



MARINE CORPS BASE HAWAII POLICY STATEMENT ON COMMISSARY USAGE



Our commissary supports our military readiness and retention and enhances the quality of life of active and retired service members and their families. Authorized patrons of the commissary include: active duty, reserve, retired service members and their dependents, as well as disabled veterans. Authorized patrons may also sponsor guests to the commissary.


The following rules apply to the commissary guest policy:

- Cashiers will conduct transactions with authorized patrons only.
- Dependent children cannot sponsor guests.
- Sponsors are responsible for their guests. Guests must:
 - Comply with all Marine Corps Base Hawaii (MCBH) guidelines, policies and orders to include the dress code policy, per MCBH Orders 1020.6 and 1020.7.
 - Show a valid picture ID.



Infractions or abuses of this policy may result in revocation of commissary privileges.

Our Commissary is a great asset and privilege. Please help us ensure that others are not abusing this privilege or disregarding our policies.
