




COMMANDING OFFICER, MARINE CORPS BASE HAWAII POLICY STATEMENT ON COMMISSARY USAGE

"AS WARRIORS, OUR COMMISSARY IS A BENEFIT WE EARNED. RESPECT IT AND PROTECT IT."

Our Commissary enhances the quality of life of active and retired service members and their families. It also supports military readiness and retention. Authorized patrons of the commissary include: active duty, reserve, and retired service members and their dependents. Authorized patrons may also sponsor guests to the commissary.

The following rules apply to the commissary guest policy:

- Authorized patrons are limited to sponsoring no more than two guests.
- Cashiers will conduct transactions with authorized patrons only.
- Dependent children cannot sponsor guests.
- Sponsors are responsible for their guests. Guests must:
 - Comply with all Marine Corps Base Hawaii guidelines, policies and orders to include the dress code policy, per Base Order 1020.5D.
 - Show a valid picture ID.



Infractions or abuses of this policy may result in revocation of commissary privileges.

Active involvement by all personnel is needed in order to effectively carry out this policy. Challenging personnel abusing commissary privileges or disregarding our policies is everyone's responsibility.
