



MARINE CORPS BASE HAWAII EXPLOSIVES DRIVER COURSE PREREQUISITES



7 July 2023

1. All personnel attending the Marine Corps Base Hawaii (MCBH) Explosives Diver Course (EDC) are required to provide the following prerequisites prior to being enrolled:

- Current civilian driver’s license
- Driver Awareness Course certificate if 25 years of age or younger
- Current explosives driver medical certificate AND wallet card
- Current OF-346 military driver license
- MCBH PMO background screening form within the last 30 days
- Ammo 18 certificate (Navy E-Learning Online)
- Ammo 51 certificate (Navy E-Learning Online)
- Current A&E Driver Course certificate (A&E driver refresher personnel only)

2. All prerequisites are due to the MCBH Explosives Safety Officer (ESO) no later than one week before the course date by close of business (1600). No late submissions will be accepted.

3. Prerequisite ammo courses 18 and 51 can be completed as follows:

- Log into NEL at <https://learning.nel.navy.mil/ELIAASv2p/>
- Once logged in and on the Learning Management System homepage, click the “Course Catalog” tab located top left of the page.
- Click on the empty field located above the course “Title” and enter either Ammo 18 or 51, hit enter.
- For ammo 18 click on "Basics of Naval Explosives Hazard Control (CERT) (Ammo-18-DL)".
- For ammo 51 click on "Naval Motor Vehicle Inspection (AMMO-51-MV-DL)".
- Click the “Enroll” button.
- Click the “My Learning” tab located top left of the page.
- The “My Learning” heading located bottom left of the page shows classes enrolled in.
- Click the “Launch” button.

4. All prerequisite submissions will be made either in person or via email. Prerequisite documentation contains personally identifiable information (PII) and will be transmitted/protected accordingly. All emails containing PII will be encrypted. Emails received, containing PII not encrypted, will be deleted with students not enrolled.

5. It is the submitting command's responsibility to ensure all copies of submitted prerequisites are legible and complete. Illegible/incomplete submissions will not be accepted. A copy of this document shall be included with each student packet. All boxes next to the prerequisites will be checked off and a command Staff NCO or higher will print and sign their name below, certifying a review/QC of the packet has been conducted and the packet is complete with all required items included and legible.
